Composition: Benzoyl Peroxide 4%.

**Indications**: It is used alone topically for mild to moderate acne and as an adjunct in acne treatment.

Dosage and administration: Wash and dry affected areas prior to application. Apply sparingly one or more times daily. Or, as directed by the registered physician.

**Contraindication**: Benzoyl peroxide should not be used by patients having known sensitivity to benzoyl peroxide or any of its components.

**Side effects**: Irritation and contact dermatitis are the most frequent side reactions to benzoyl peroxide.

**Precautions:** For external use only. Not for ophthalmic use keep away from eyes and mucosa. May bleach colored fabrics. Keep this medication out of the reach of children.

Use in pregnancy and lactation: It is not known whether benzoyl peroxide can cause fetal harm when administered to a pregnant woman or can affect reproduction capacity. Benzoyl peroxide should be given to a pregnant woman only if clearly needed. It is not known whether this drug is excreted in human milk. Because many drugs are excreted in human milk, caution should be exercised when benzoyl peroxide is administered to a nursing woman. Pregnancy Category C.
