Composition: Cefpodoxime + Clavulanic Acid; (100mg+62.5mg) & (200mg+125mg) Tablet.

Indications: It is indicated in the following infections when caused by susceptible organisms: Acute bacterial exacerbations of chronic bronchitis, Acute community acquired pneumonia, Upper and lower respiratory tract infections, Skin and soft tissue infections, Urinary tract infections, Pharyngitis and/or tonsillitis, General gonorrhea (men and women) and rectal gonococcal infections (women), Acute maxillary sinusitis.

Use in pregnancy and lactation : Cefpodoxine has been assigned to pregnancy category B by the FDA.

Drug Interactions: Concomitant administration of high doses of antacids (Sodium Bicarbonate and Aluminium Hydroxide) or H2 blockers reduces peak plasma level by 24% to 42% and the extent of absorption by 27% to 32% respectively.

Contraindication: It is contraindicated in patients with known hypersensitivity to the drug.

Side effects: Side effects are diarrhea, nausea, abdominal pain, headache, painful or urination, unusual weakness, easy bleeding and bruising, confusion, dry mouth, chills, body aches, fever, sore throat.

Precautions: Cefpodoxime, like other cephalosporins, should be administered with caution to patients receiving concurrent treatment with potent diuretics. In patients with renal impairment, dosage should be adjusted.
