

Composition : Each Soft Gelatin Capsule Contains Phytomenadione (Vitamin K₁) BP 1 mg.

Indication : Phytomenadione (Vitamin K₁) is indicated for the prevention of Vitamin K₁ Deficiency Bleeding (VKDB) in new born babies.

Dosage & Administration : Phytomenadione (Vitamin K₁) soft gelatin capsule should be administered squeezing the Liquid into the baby's mouth. One capsule is to be administered at birth and another dose should be given if the First dose is spat out. For babies who are being exclusively breastfed, a dose of 1 mg once weekly for 12 weeks is recommended for the prevention of late Vitamin K₁ Deficiency Bleeding. Or, as directed by the registered physician.

Contraindications : It is contraindicated in babies with known hypersensitivity to Vitamin K₁ or any other components of this product.

Precautions : Before giving Phytomenadione (Vitamin K₁) soft capsule physician's advice should be taken for babies currently on treatment with Warfarin for Protein C or Protein S deficiency.

Side effects : No side effects have been associated with Oral administration.

Drug Interactions : Phytomenadione (Vitamin K₁) acts as an antidote to the anticoagulant drugs of the coumarin type, therefore concomitant use is not recommended except in the treatment of Warfarin overdose. It is not an antidote to heparin.
