

## Diproxen Gel

**Composition :** Naproxen Sodium 10%.

**Indications :** This gel is indicated for treatment of rheumatoid arthritis, osteoarthritis, ankylosing spondylitis, tendonitis, bursitis, acute gout, and the management of mild to moderate pain and primary dysmenorrhoea.

**Dosage and administration :** Diproxen Gel is to be applied 2-6 times a day as required and is not recommended for use in children. Or, as directed by the registered physician.

**Contraindication :** Naproxen is contraindicated in patients with active peptic ulceration, hypersensitivity to Naproxen or Naproxen Sodium formulations, aspirin/other NSAIDs.

**Side effects :** Dermatological Hypersensitivity- skin rashes, urticaria, angio-oedema; rarely anaphylactic reactions and eosinophilic pneumonitis are reported with Naproxen.

**Precaution :** Naproxen Gel should not be applied near eyes, mucous membranes or open wounds, if a rash or irritation occurs during naproxen gel use, treatment should be discontinued.

**Pregnancy and lactation :** Pregnancy Category-C

**Packing :** Diproxen Gel : 15gm in a tube.
