Composition: Naproxen Sodium 10%.

Indications: This gel is indicated for treatment of rheumatoid arthritis, osteoarthritis, ankylosing spondylitis, tendonitis, bursitis, acute gout, and the management of mild to moderate pain and primary dysmenorrhoea.

Dosage and administration: Diproxen Gel is to be applied 2-6 times a day as required and is not recommended for use in children. Or, as directed by the registered physician.

Contraindication: Naproxen is contraindicated in patients with active peptic ulceration, hypersensitivity to Naproxen or Naproxen Sodium formulations, aspirin/other NSAIDs.

Side effects: Dermatological Hypersensitivity- skin rashes, urticaria, angio-oedema; rarely anaphylactic reactions and eosinophilic pneumonitis are reported with Naproxen.

Precaution: Naproxen Gel should not be applied near eyes, mucous membranes or open wounds, if a rash or irritation occurs during naproxen gel use, treatment should be discontinued.

Pregnancy and lactation : Pregnancy Category-C

Packing: Diproxen Gel: 15gm in a tube.
