**Composition**: Indapamide+Perindopril Erbumine; (1.25mg+2mg) & (1.25mg+4mg) Tablet.

**Indications**: It is indicated in the treatment of essential hypertension where blood pressure is not adequately controlled on perindopril alone.

Dosage and administration: 1-2 tablet of Indapa-plus 2 or One tablet of Indapa-plus 4 per day preferably taken in the morning before meal. In case of renal insufficiency treatment should be start with an adequate dose.

**Contraindication :** This fixed combination is contraindicated in following situations. Hypersensitivity to perindopril/ indapamide or to any other angiotensin-converting enzyme (ACE) inhibitor.

**Side effects:** Side-effects include nausea, vomiting, dyspepsia, diarrhea, constipation, headache, dizziness, sleep disturbance, asthenia, dry mouth, hypotension, persistent dry cough, angioedema, rash.

Precautions: The drug should be used cautiously in the following situations- in renal impairment, renal artery stenosis, heart failure, gout, diabetes, liver cirrhosis, in elderly patient, atherosclerosis, idiopathic or hereditary angioedema.

Use in Pregnancy and lactation: There are no adequate and well-controlled studies in pregnant woman. So in pregnancy Indapa-plus is not recommended. Mothers taking Indapa-plus should not breast feed.

**Drug interactions**: Concomitant use of antihypertensive & antipsychotic drug may

potentiate hypotensive effect and NSAIDs may reduce antihypertensive effect. ARB and Potassium Sparing diuretics may cause hyperkalaemia.

Packing: Indapa-Plus 2: 2x10's tablets in blister pack.
