

Composition:

Trialon Cream: Triamcinolone Acetonide 0.1% .

Indications : This is indicated for the relief of the inflammatory and pruritic manifestations of corticosteroid-responsive dermatoses.

Dosage and administration : It should be applied to affected area two or three times daily. Or, as directed by the registered physician.

Side effects : The side effects of this drug are-burning, itching, irritation, hypertrichosis, acneiform eruptions, hypopigmentation, allergic contact dermatitis, secondary infection, skin atrophy, striae, miliaria.

Contraindication : It is contraindicated in those patients with hypersensitivity to any component of this drug.

Use in Pregnancy and Lactation :
In Pregnancy: There is no clinical experience with this drug in pregnant women. Therefore, this product should be used during pregnancy only if the potential benefit justifies the potential risk to the fetus. Lactation: Caution should be exercised when this product is administered to a nursing woman.

Drug interactions : There are no known drug interactions with this drug.

Precautions : It is for external use only. Patient should be avoided contact with eyes. If irritation develops, the product should be discontinued and appropriate therapy instituted.

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Packing : Trialon Cream : Each tube contains 10gm Cream.
