

Composition : Neomycin Sulphate 0.5% & Bacitracin Zinc 1%.

Indications : Neo-B ointment is indicated in the treatment of topical bacterial infection. It is particularly effective in atopic, contact, stasis, eczematoid dermatitis, neurodermatitis, eczema, and anogenital pruritus. It may also be useful as an adjunct in certain pyodermas such as impetigo, during specific systemic antibiotic therapy for these infections.

Dosage & administration : A thin film to be applied 2 to 4 times daily to the affected area. Or as directed by the physician.

Contraindications : It is contraindicated in those individuals who have shown hypersensitivity to any of its components. It should not be used in the external ear canal if the eardrum is perforated.

Precautions : Because of the potential hazard or nephro-toxicity due to neomycin, care should be exercised when using this product in treating extensive burns, trophic ulceration and other extensive conditions where absorption of neomycin is possible. As with any antibiotic preparation, prolonged use may result in the overgrowth of non-susceptible organisms including fungi.

Side effect : Articles in the current medical literature indicate an increase in the prevalence of persons allergic to

neomycin.

Use in pregnancy and lactation :

There are no adequate and well-controlled studies in pregnant women. This ointment should be used during pregnancy only if the potential benefit justifies the potential risk to the fetus. Caution should be exercised when Neo-B ointment is administered to nursing women.

Packing : Neo-B Ointment : 10gm in a tube.
