Syrup Buzuri

## Antipyretic & Diuretic

### Description:

The pharmaceutically active constituent of buzuri is very effective for increasing of urine output. In excessive heat, fever, intake of unwanted chemical substance, antibiotic when unwanted excretion is necessary and major excretion media is urine, burning sensation during micturation urinary tract infection and in other cases use of Buzuri is highly beneficial for the treatment of urinary diseases.

### Composition :

Each 5ml syrup contains extract of-

<i>Cichorium intybus</i> (Root)	250.00 mg
<i>Cucumis melo</i> (Seed)	250.00 mg
<i>Foeniculum vulgare</i> (Root)	125.00 mg
<i>Foeniculum vulgare</i> (Seed)	125.00 mg
<i>Cichorium intybus</i> (Seed)	125.00 mg
<i>Tribulus terrestris</i>	125.00 mg

### Indications :

- \* Pyrexia
- \* Oliguria
- \* Amenorrhoea
- \* Hepatitis
- \* Obstructive jaundice
- \* It is very effective to clear the morbid substances from the kidney and urinary bladder.

### Dosage :

Adult : 2-4 teaspoonfuls two to four times daily.

Children : 1-2 teaspoonfuls two to four times daily.

Or, as directed by the registered physician.

### Contraindication :

Buzuri is contraindicated in case of renal failure patients.

### Side effects :

No significant side effects have been observed in proper dosage.

### Storage :

Store in a cool and dry place away from direct sunlight. Keep it out of reach of children.

### Presentation :

100ml & 450ml in PET bottle.
