**Composition**: **Dsec-30**: Each Capsule Contains Dexlansoprazole INN 30mg as enteric coated granules.

**Dsec-60**: Each Capsule Contains Dexlansoprazole INN 60mg as enteric coated granules. **Pharmacology**: Dexlansoprazole delayed-release capsule is a Proton Pump Inhibitor (PPI) that inhibits gastric acid secretion. Dexlansoprazole is the R-enantiomer of lansoprazole (A racemic mixture of the R- and S-enantiomers). Dexlansoprazole is supplied as a Dual Delayed Release (DDR) formulation in a capsule for oral administration. Dexlansoprazole capsule contains a mixture of two types of enteric coated granules with different PH-dependent dissolution profiles.

Dexlansoprazole is PPI that suppressor gastric acid secretion by specific inhibition of the (H+/K+)- ATPase in the gastric parietal cell. By acting specially on the proton pump, Dexlansoprazole blocks the final step of acid production.

Indications: Dexlansoprazole is indicated for-

- . Healing of Erosive Esophagitis (EE).
- . Maintenance of Healed Erosive Esophagitis.
- Symptomatic Non-Erosive Gastroesophageal Reflux Disease (GERD).

**Dosage and administration**: Dexlansoprazole dosing recommendations

Indication	Recommended Dose	Frequency
Healing of EE	60 mg	Once daily for up to 8 weeks
Maintenance of Healed EE	30 mg	Once daily
Symptomatic Non-Erosive GERD	30 mg	Once daily for 4 weeks

- . Dexlansoprazole can be taken with or without food.
- . This capsules should be swallowed whole; Should not be chewed.
- . Alternatively, capsules can be administered as follows:
  - Open capsule.
  - Sprinkle intact granules on 1 table spoon.
  - Swallow immediately. Granules should not be chewed.

Or, as directed by the registered physicians.





**Side effects**: Common side effects include headache, nausea, vomiting, diarrhoea, abdominal pain, upper respiratory tract infection and flatulence.

**Contraindication**: Dexlansoprazole is contraindicated in patients with known hypersensitivity to any component of the formulation.

**Drug Interaction**: Dexlansoprazole should not be co-administered with Atazanavir, Warfarin, Tacrolimus, Clopidogrel & Methotrexate.

**Use in pregnancy and lactation :** Pregnancy Category B. There are no adequate and well-controlled studies with dexlansoprazole in pregnant women. It is not known whether dexlansoprazole is excreted in human milk.

**Precaution**: Gastric malignancy, Clostridium difficile associated diarrhoea, bone fracture, hypomagnesemia, concomitant use of Dexlansoprazole with Methotrexate.

**Overdose**: There have been no reports of significant overdose of Dexlansoprazole. Multiple doses of Dexlansoprazole 120mg and a single dose of Dexlansoprazole 300mg did not result in any severe adverse events.

**Storage**: Away from light. Keep all medicines away from children.

**Packing : Dsec-30 :** Each box contains 30's capsule in alu-alu blister pack.

**Dsec-60**: Each box contains 28's capsule in alu-alu blister pack.
