

Composition : Each ml of Fenat eye drop contains : Ketotifen BP 0.25mg (as Ketotifen Fumarate).

Indications : Ketotifen eye drop is indicated for the temporary prevention of itching of the eye due to allergic conjunctivitis.

Dosage and administration : Adult use : The recommended dose is one drop in the affected eye twice daily every 8 - 12 hours, no more than twice per day.

Pediatric use : Safety and efficacy of this eye drop have not been established in pediatric patients below the age of 3 years. Or, as directed by the registered physician.

Contraindication: It is contraindicated in person with a known hypersensitivity to any of this product.

Pregnancy and Lactation : There is no well-controlled study in human pregnancy. Fenat eye drop should be used during pregnancy only if clearly needed. Nevertheless, caution should be exercised when ketotifen is administered to a nursing mother.

Side effects : Allergic reactions, burning or stinging, conjunctivitis, discharge, dry eyes, eye pain, eyelid disorder, itching,

keratitis, lacrimation disorder, mydriasis, photophobia and rash.

Precautions : To prevent contamination of the dropper tip and solution, care should be taken not to touch the eyelids or surrounding areas with the dropper tip of the bottle. Keep the bottle tightly closed when not in use.

Packing: Fenat eye drops : 5ml in plastic dropper bottle.
