Composition: Dialiptin-50: Each film coated tablet contains Vildagliptin INN 50mg.

Pharmacology: Vildagliptin is a dipeptidylpeptidase-4 (DPP-4) inhibitor, which is believed to exert its actions in patients with type 2 diabetes by slowing the inactivation of incretin hormones. Vildagliptin increases insulin release and decreases glucagon levels in the circulation in a glucose-dependent manner.

Indications: Vildagliptin is indicated for the treatment of type 2 diabetes mellitus (in combination with metformin or with a sulphonylurea or with a thiazolidinedione).

Dosage and administration: Adult over 18 years: Vildagliptin administered in combination with metformin or a thiazolidinedione, 50mg twice daily; in combination with a sulphonylurea, 50mg daily in the morning. Or, as directed by the registered physician.

Contraindication: It is contraindicated for patients with diabetic ketoacidosis, hepatic impairment, kidney dysfunction.

Precautions: Caution should be employed for elderly patients. It should be used with caution in patients with impaired hepatic function and heart failure.

Side effects: The most common side effects associated with Vildagliptin therapy include headache, tremor, dizziness, nausea and asthenia. Less commonly constipation, hypoglycemia.

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Pregnancy and lactation: Vildagliptin should be avoided during pregnancy or breast feeding unless essential.

Use in Child: Safety and effectiveness of Vildagliptin in pediatric patients under 18 years of age have not been established.

Drug Interactions: As a result of clinically studies relevant no with other interactions oral (glibenclamide, antidiabetics pioglitazone, metformin), amlodipine, digoxin, ramipril, simvastatin, valsartan or warfarin observed after were COadministration with vildagliptin.

Overdose: Muscle pain, mild and transient paraesthesia, fever, oedema and transient increase in lipase levels.

Storage: Store below 30°C in a dry place.

Packing: Dialiptin-50: Each box contains 3 x 14's tablets in blister pack.
