Composition:

Cetirizine Dihydrochloride 10mg Tablet.

Indications: Cetrin is indicated in -

Allergic rhinitis for relief from nasal congestion, sneezing, rhinorrhoea, ocular symptoms like redness, lacrimation and itching. Allergic dermatological conditions like urticaria, dermographism, atopic eczema and contact dermatitis. Acute allergic reactions due to drugs, foods insect bites, etc.

Dosage and administration: Cetrin tablet: Adults and children 12 years and older: one Cetrin tablet (10mg) once daily.

Contraindication : Cetrin is contraindicated in patients who are hypersensitive to the drug.

Adverse reactions: Cetrin is well tolerated. The reported adverse reactions at the recommended dosage is low. Most adverse effects are mild. Drowsiness, headache, G.I. disturbance, dizziness or anti-cholinergic effects may occur.
